

On Saturday 23rd June we welcomed back the Harlequin Singers and their new conductor, and enjoyed a rich variety of sacred and secular music. From the proceeds of this concert we were pleased to donate £50 to the Weston Hospital scanner appeal.

Heritage Open Days, a celebration of our diverse history, architecture and culture, will take place from the 13th - 16th September, and as always we shall be delighted to see you at All Saints, described by John Betjeman as, 'the finest church of entirely modern foundation in Somerset'. The church will be open from 10 am - 4 pm on Thursday 13th and Friday 14th and refreshments will be provided.

Our 'Bring and Share' lunches unite our church family in food and fellowship, but are open to anyone after Sunday Mass, and the next lunch on Sunday 4th November will be a celebration of our Patronal Festival.

Finally, on the 3rd Sunday of each month, beginning Sunday 21st October, we extend the warmest of welcomes to you all, when we bring God's message and His love to our parish in the Locking Road area. 'Church at St Saviour's hall' will take place at 10.30 am every third Sunday. This marks a very exciting 'next step' in our outreach and mission, and we look forward to seeing you all there.
